I, personally, have very much enjoyed being President of our Club for the past year and look forward to continuing in my role in 2021-22.





#### Program Coordinator's Report

We had 111 activities on the 2020/21 program: this is a healthy improvement on the heavily Covid-affected numbers of 2019/20 (99), and while we're not back up to our previous numbers of about 130 per year, this is mostly due to fewer social activities rather than fewer walks.

Walks were mostly grades 2 (28%) and 3 (37%). In last year's report I noted that 40% were grade 2 and 20% grade 3, so this year's figures show that the grading calculator revisions a year ago have had the desired effect of widening the grade 3 category.

Standout contributors have been Leah Taylor and Jacqui Joseph, but Denise Kruse, Liam Heery and Nick Collins are hot on their heels, and I thank all members who have led an activity this year - particularly new leaders Elaine Wen and Mel Razmjoo.

#### Membership Secretary's Report

For our reporting year from April 1 (2020) to March 31 (2021), there were 135 members as of March 31, 2021.

Between April 1 (2020) and March 31 (2021) we gained 26 new members.

From previous records as at March 2020, we had 119 members.

Between April 2019 and March 2020 we had 24 new members.

As at March 2019, we had 136 members.

Between April 2018 and March 2019 we had 36 new members.

Reminders for ANB Membership Renewals were sent to 31 members and 20 have renewed. For those who didn't renew main reasons given were: finding it difficult to join walks because of casual work commitments; and because of other interests.

Membership expiry dates were extended by 6 months from March 1 to September 1, 2020 with the advent of the COVID-19 virus last year.
