Summer Membership of the Brindabella Ski Club







Summer Members may book and enjoy the facilities of any of the Brindabella Ski Club's lodges outside the peak winter period, paying Members' accommodation rates.

The peak winter period is from the long weekend in June until the long weekend in October; thus Summer Members are free to book anytime outside this period.

Summer members may also book in to the lodges *during winter* but must pay the *Associate accommodation rate*.

The club keeps the cost of using its facilities low by means of its "self-help" ethos. Much of the activity associated with operation of the club is carried out by volunteers. For example, guests are expected to perform cleaning and other maintenance duties to leave the lodges ready for the next guests.

Our Lodges

Waragun (Thredbo)



Thredbo Village is a year-round resort and offers additional activities such as golf, tennis and swimming, and has a number of restaurants which open outside the winter period.

Tiobunga and Kyilla (Guthega)



Guthega Village offers a peaceful experience and a real opportunity to "get away from it all" in one of the most scenic spots in the Snowy Mountains, directly adjacent to the Main Range. Its location is ideal for accessing various attractive walking destinations. The club has provided books and topographic maps to help lodge users to select suitable walks to enjoy. The Guthega Alpine Hotel opens outside the winter period and meals may be obtained there by arrangement with the owners.

How much does Summer Membership cost?

The membership fees for the current year can be found on the Club website. There is a joining fee and an annual membership fee; junior fees (3 to 18 years) are half the adult rate. Fees are reviewed annually and may rise, so please check with the Membership Officer if in doubt.

Junior members must always be accompanied in the lodges by an Adult Member.

Full Members and Summer Members are expected to participate in at least one work party every five years.

How can I join as a Summer Member?

Sponsorship by an existing full club member is **required**, and aspiring Summer Members are encouraged to participate in a work party and/or utilise the lodges in the company of a member prior to applying.
